

Educators for Black Lives Rapid Response Grant Fund: FAQ

Q: Is an organization able to apply for funding for multiple projects?

A: No, an organization is only able to apply for one project.

Q: My school is leading work on anti-racism, can we apply for this grant?

A: While work focused on eradicating anti-racism is crucial, this grant opportunity is focused on the particular type of subtle and overt racism that harms Black people known as anti-Blackness or anti-Black racism. For this grant opportunity, the Foundation is prioritizing projects that are focused on challenging anti-Blackness in schools and communities.

Q: Can this rapid response grant be used for operating support or to support an ongoing program?

A: No, the rapid response grant cannot be used for operating support or to fund an ongoing program.

Q: Are institutions of higher education eligible to apply?

A: Institutions of higher education are eligible to apply for this grant opportunity if the project is in direct support of current public K-12 educators.

Q: My organization was previously awarded a rapid response grant in March 2020. Are we eligible for this opportunity?

A: No, organizations are only eligible for one rapid response grant each year.
